## CATEGORIES AND RESTRICTIONS

U8 RED BALL > Athletes born in 2016, 2017, or 2018;

U9 ORANGE BALL > Athletes born in 2015 or 2016;

U10 GREEN BALL > Athletes born in 2014 or 2015;

U12 > Athletes born in 2012 or 2013;

U14 > Athletes born in 2010 or 2011 are eligible to participate.

Athletes are permitted to compete in only one age group.

## TOURNAMENT STRUCTURE

U8 Red Ball Division

It is conducted as a single event, featuring a mixed-gender match  
format comprising single sets of 20 points each, designed to promote  
encouragement in accordance with the TTF U8 regulations.

- In instances of high participation, two or more fixtures may be arranged.
- All athletes are scheduled to compete against one another at least once over a span of five days.



### U9, U10, U12, U14 CATEGORIES

The initial 2-3 days of the tournament will feature the 1st Stage Group matches, succeeded by the 2nd Stage (Final) Group matches based on the rankings.

Athletes competing in the tournament will engage in a minimum of four matches.

In addition to the trophy presented to the victorious athletes, all participating competitors will receive medals, certificates, and gifts.

There is no entry fee for the tournament. The authority to accept external participants resides with the organizing committee.

Participation in each category is restricted to 32 athletes.

### TOURNAMENT INFORMATION

The JOLLY JUNIOR CUP organized by CORENDON is a tournament for the U8, U9, U10, U12, and U14 age categories, specifically for athletes born between 2008 and 2018.



- In the tournament, each participant is assured a minimum of four singles matches over the course of five days.
- Registration to compete in multiple categories is not permitted. For instance, an athlete born in 2015 may not register in both the U9 and U10 categories. They must choose only one category on the application form.

### IDENTITY AUTHENTICATION

Each participant is required to possess a valid ID card or passport and must present it to the tournament officials during registration.

On match days, every player is required to be present at the table promptly upon arrival at the courts, and this must occur at least 15 minutes prior to the match.

### ON-COURT COACHING

During the tournament, on-court coaching is permitted solely for the U12 and U14 categories. This allows the coach or parent to approach the sidelines once at the conclusion of a set, for a maximum duration of 2 minutes.

During a match, a player may consult their coach at the following times:

- Once per set (only at the conclusion of the set)
- Requests must be directed to the designated observer referee.

The maximum permitted duration is 120 seconds.

- Once the head referee or the observer declares, "Time is up," the court must be vacated immediately.

Verbal or gestural coaching is prohibited for the duration of the match and may lead to a breach of the rules. Penalties for such infractions may include the loss of a point, game, or set, forfeiture, or expulsion from the tournament, at the discretion of the head referee.

### RESULTS

The tournament results will be available on [www.coredontennisclub.com](http://www.coredontennisclub.com) within one week following the conclusion of the tournament.

### GAME REGULATIONS:

Short Sets denote collections of 4 games, while Normal Sets signify collections of 6 games.

All categories will be contested using the number of sets indicated in the table. When the score reaches 4:4 or 6:6 in a set, a 7-point Set Tie Break will be conducted.



- In the event of a 1-1 tie in sets, a 10-point Match Tie Break will be played in the U9, U12, and U14 categories. Similarly, matches in the U10 category will proceed to a third set.
- In the event of a 40:40 tie in game points, the Advantage points rule (No-ad points) will not be implemented. The player receiving the serve will select the receiving side.

### CAPTAINS' MEETING, FIXTURES, AND MATCH SCHEDULE

As of November 10, 2024 – 19:00, Corendon Tennis Club, Kemer

General information regarding the process will be provided to athletes, parents, and coaches. Following attendance verification, designated groups and match schedules will be released.

Upon the completion of tournament registrations (November 5, 2024), the chief referee will organize all athletes into groups of up to four, with any remaining athletes assigned to groups of five, according to the total number of registrations within each category.

The primary objective when making these selections is to minimize, to the greatest extent possible, the presence of athletes from the same club within the same elimination group.

When forming groups, neither national nor international rankings will be considered. In summary, a seeding system will not be implemented. Fixtures and the match schedule for the first day will be posted on the Corendon Tennis Club Kemer tournament board and on [www.coredontennisclub.com](http://www.coredontennisclub.com).

The fixtures and match schedules for the upcoming days will be released on these channels no later than 60 minutes following the conclusion of the final matches.

### WARM-UP AND EXERCISE

The courts will be available for service starting at 08:00. One court must be shared among four players at all times.



On November 10, 2024, each athlete will be allotted a maximum of one hour of court time between 08:00 and 18:00.

For the period of November 1-15, 2024;

08:00 – 08:30 for players competing for 1st and 2nd place,

For players competing for 3rd and 4th place, the time is scheduled from 08:30 to 08:55.

Players engaged in matches across different ranks may be paired with these individuals for morning training sessions. Following the matches, the courts will remain accessible until 18:00. Court reservations can be arranged at the tournament desk.

### PRIZES

On the final day of the tournament, once each athlete has completed their match, they are required to approach the head referee to inquire about their ranking. Athletes who receive a ranking will be awarded the cup designated by the head referee and will have the opportunity to take a commemorative photo in the designated photo blog area within the Tournament venue.

Participation medals and certificates will be awarded to all athletes on the final day.

### ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

Tennis balls; Matches will be conducted using the ball brand selected by the organizing committee. The organization will not supply warm-up balls.

Court type: All matches will be conducted on clay courts.

Dress code: A tennis uniform and appropriate tennis shoes for the surface are required during the competition.

Physical and legal condition: We would like to remind you that tournament participants must be healthy and in optimal physical condition. Only individuals in good health are permitted to compete.





**Insurance:** Each participant is responsible for securing their own insurance throughout the tournament.

**Expenses:** Participants are entirely accountable for organizing travel, accommodation, insurance, visas (if necessary), and all other costs related to this tournament.

**Liability:** Corendon and Jolly Tur shall not be held accountable for any misuse of the aforementioned.

**Tournament participation fees:** Participation in the tournament is complimentary for athletes residing at the Corendon Playa Kemer Hotel.

**Registration Deadline:** The registration closing date is 5 November 2024 at 18:00.

**Authorization:** In the event that matches are interrupted or delayed due to unforeseen circumstances, such as inclement weather, the head referee possesses the authority to modify the time, court, date, and scoring formats of the matches to ensure the tournament concludes on the designated day and time.

The organizing committee and the referee committee shall not be held liable for matches that are delayed or cannot be conducted due to unforeseen circumstances.

The Organization Management possesses the authority to implement all the aforementioned changes to guarantee the successful continuation of the Tournament.
